

Mount Cain Alpine Park Society Policy – Snowmobile Use in Cabin Area

The following policy is in effect immediately for the use of snowmobiles within the designated cabin area at Mount Cain.

1. Only snowmobiles registered to cabin owners and displaying a flag with the corresponding cabin number printed on it are permitted in the cabin area. The Society will provide the flags at a nominal cost to each cabin owner.
2. Every snowmobile registered to a cabin owner must comply with the motion made at the August 12, 2006 board meeting. The motion states that the owner of each snowmobile must register the snowmobile and insure it through the BC Snowmobile Association and buy the optional \$1 million liability coverage. The Society has application forms available.
3. Cabin owners' snowmobiles **are prohibited** from operating in the cabin area between the hours of:
 - 9:00 am and 4:00 pm on days that the ski hill is in operation, and
 - between 11:00 pm and 7:00 am (every evening).
4. Snowmobiles are to be used for delivering goods to and from your cabin, **NO joy riding within the cabin area.**
5. The speed limit is “dead slow” at all times.
6. Be respectful of others by minimizing the number of trips to and from your cabin.
7. The pedestrian path connecting the Lower and Upper cabin roads is off limits to snowmobiles at all times.
8. This policy excludes snowmobiles owned and operated by MCAPS.
9. Private snowmobiles are NEVER permitted on the ski hill.
